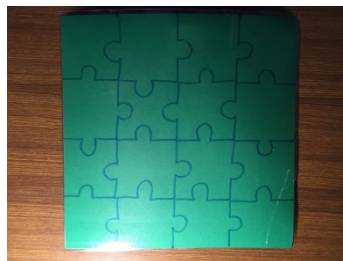


Lockout Hasp CBCA Shortlist Treasure Hunt

Things you will need: 1 toolbox / treasure chest

- 1 Lockout Hasp
- 6 combination padlocks (reusable)
- 6 Book Cover Images (laminated and cut into 16 puzzle pieces)
- 1 dry eraser (for marking out puzzle pieces)
- 6 zip lock bags
- 6 sets of clues that use Worldbookonline to help solve the missing words



How does it work?



2018 Early Childhood Shortlist

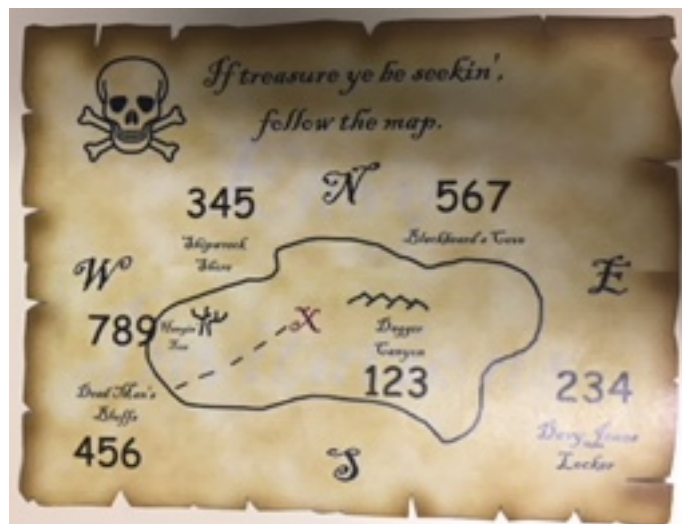
- *solve the clues using *Worldbookonline Kids* (search **bold print**)
- *unlock the padlock and follow the treasure map
- *complete the puzzle to find your shortlisted title

Students work in groups to solve the clues.



Once clues are worked out then student groups can unlock their padlock. Once all six groups have unlocked their padlock then they can find the correct puzzle bag for their group to solve.



Groups collect their shortlisted book from treasure box.



Groups describe their treasure (shortlisted book) to the rest of class after reading the blurb and walking through the book.
